Mission in the World: Song and Story

Materials used by the conference choir during the Music workshop and conference liturgy.

Summary of the Workshop – points to remember

- Select material that enhances participation simple to learn, repetitive or call/response music will serve this purpose.
- Select material that reflects the themes of the day from the readings and Gospel.
- Try to include something in another language. This may be a verse in a different language or the whole song. This reminds us that we are part of a global church and helps us to look through the eyes of 'another' for a brief moment.
- Everyone can sing, when you do it more often you improve.
- You can sing without instruments, using percussion only, you just need one or more strong voices to lead.
- Practice boosts confidence and skill levels.

Listen to a recording of a hymn/song, sing with it, then try it without the recording.

Some recommended starting points:

Songs of the World Church: Many and Great; Wild Goose Worship Group (Iona Community; CD and Songbook. Songs of the World Church: Send by the Lord; Wild Goose Worship Group (Iona Community); CD and Songbook.
